Scholarships for the Spring 2012 term will be awarded to four current Language and Culture Center (LCC) students on the basis of academic excellence, leadership, and cross-cultural awareness and understanding. The Valdes scholarship and the Davidson scholarship will cover tuition and all fees except books. The two Merit scholarships will each be \$1,500.00 applied to tuition. The students receiving the scholarships will be chosen by a committee of LCC faculty and staff. The committee will evaluate the above factors by looking at many things, including students' applications, academic progress, good attendance, and teachers' recommendations. **Students in levels 1 through 5 are eligible to apply. Students who owe money to the LCC on November 18, 2011, cannot be considered for the scholarships.**

Due to the limited number of scholarships we have to offer, students who already have a scholarship or sponsorship from another source (for example, your government, university, or place of employment), or who have previously received an LCC scholarship, may not apply.

You must be present at the graduation ceremony to receive the scholarship. If you are not present, the scholarship will be given to another student.

THE DEADLINE FOR THIS APPLICATION IS **NOVEMBER 18, 2011**, NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THAT DATE. THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE GRADUATION CEREMONY **DECEMBER 15, 2011**.
