What computer services does the Language and Culture Center (LCC) offer?

The Language and Culture Center (LCC) has a Computer Assisted Language Learning (CALL) Lab reserved for LCC students. During class time, your teacher may take you there to practice on a variety of different computerized language learning programs. These programs will allow you to learn, practice, and improve your English. If you do not have CALL Lab time during regular class time, the open hours are Monday through Friday, 12:30-1:30 p.m.

What can I do in CALL Lab?

You can access academic resources including:

- Typing Tutor: This program will help you improve your typing skills.
- Practice for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
- Audacity: This is a listening and recording program to practice speaking.
- Oxford Picture Dictionary Interactive (OPDI): You can explore any topics of your interest, learn new words, watch videos, and play games.
- Reader's Corner: You can explore a great variety of books and e-books.
- Focus on Grammar: Practice your grammar knowledge.

You can also request help from the CALL Lab Program Assistants with:

- AccessUH account, including Cougarnet account, passwords
- Information and Liability Release Form
- LCC Student Handbook
- Student Health Insurance Plan account

Printing credits do not roll over into the next term. After all credits are used, additional printing is charged to your CougarCard Flex accounts. The costs are listed below.


- Black-and-white printing costs 1.5 cents/side
- Color printing costs 10 cents/side
- Copies are 1.5 cents/side (black-and-white only)
