

## Permission for Emergency Treatment Form

*Required for Students Under Age 18*

On rare occasions, an emergency requiring hospitalization or surgery may occur to students. Those under the age of 18, also known as minors, may not be administered an anesthetic or be operated upon without written consent of a parent or legal guardian. Prior to enrolling in the Language and Culture Center (LCC), a student under the age of 18 must submit this form, signed by the student's parent or legal guardian, to the LCC.
