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UH Transfer Rules

- Courses taken at WCJC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

Major Requirements

- B.S. Math: complete 12 hours of approved mathematics courses.
 Students majoring in Exercise Science – Primary Option will fulfill this requirement through the major coursework.
- B.S. Natural Science: complete 8 hours of science courses. Students majoring in Exercise Science – Primary Option will fulfill this requirement through the major coursework.
- Complete PHED 1301, KIN 2304, KIN 3304, KIN 3306, KIN 3309, KIN 4310, and KIN 4370 with a C- or better.
- This major does not require a CLASS Diversity course, CLASS Block courses, or a minor.
